A native of Denton, Texas, Lisa has been involved extensively in the Dallas-Fort Worth/Denton dance community for the past 30 years. After graduating with a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Ballet from Texas Christian University, Ms. Racina-Torre opened Denton Dance Conservatory (DDC) in 1988. The students of DDC have gained recognition from such highly acclaimed dance programs as the San Francisco Ballet School, Joffrey Ballet, DanceAspen, Interlochen Arts School, Oklahoma City Ballet, Ballet Austin, Alvin Ailey Dance and others.

Founder of *Denton City Contemporary Ballet*, the studio's resident non-profit affiliate company, and the *Denton Youth City Ballet*, and Artistic Director of both companies, Lisa hosts the *Collage Denton Dance Festival* each year, inviting guest companies to join Denton dancers on stage. The company's holiday production, "*A Gift for Emma*" is also Ms. Racina-Torre's creation. This show has become a Denton favorite!

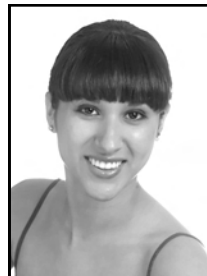
She has choreographed for musical theatre with *Music Theatre of Denton*, the *Denton Community Theatre*, & the *University of North Texas' Drama Department*. In 2000 & 2003 she was one of only 20 nation-wide accepted to the *Glenda Brown Choreography Conference* in Houston. A former Adjunct Professor at the *University of North Texas Dance Department*, Lisa has also taught at the *Interlochen Arts Academy* in Michigan.

Ms. Racina-Torre's company, *Denton City Contemporary Ballet*, will be one of ten dance companies from the United States touring with the *Young Tanzsommer Arts Festival* in Austria in June 2011.

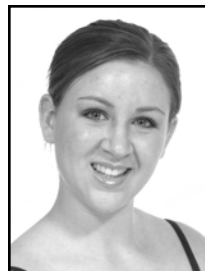
